## A2. EDUCATIONAL RESOURCES AND DIGITAL TOOLS FOR SOCIAL INTEGRATION

Under Activity 2, partners worked together to develop practical, accessible tools that support youth workers in creating inclusive environments for migrant youth. The team produced a set of creative, step-by-step activities including concept mapping, storytelling circles, migration maps, stereotype awareness exercises, and cultural identity reflections.

All resources were designed to be easy to use, adaptable to different cultural contexts, and suitable for both face-to-face and digital learning environments

## CREATING THE YOUTH WORKER ACTIVITY BOOK

During this phase, partners created the Youth Worker Activity Book, a structured collection of methods that help youth workers facilitate safe dialogue, strengthen empathy, and promote intercultural understanding. The book includes:

- visual thinking activities
- storytelling and identity exercises
- inclusive group dynamics tasks

Each activity provides clear instructions, materials, timing, and reflection questions, making it simple for youth workers to apply in their daily work.



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## DEVELOPING DIGITAL TOOLS FOR ENGAGEMENT

Alongside the activity book, partners developed digital templates, visual supports, and recommendations for online adaptation. These tools help youth workers run sessions on platforms (such as Padlet, Jamboard, Mentimeter, or Canva) ensuring the activities can be used in hybrid or fully online settings. The digital approach enhances flexibility and supports migrant youth with diverse language levels and accessibility needs.

## PILOTING ACTIVITIES WITH LOCAL YOUTH GROUPS

Each partner organisation tested selected activities with youth groups in Belgium, Türkiye, and Austria. The piloting phase allowed teams to refine instructions, adjust cultural references, and ensure the materials are youth friendly. Feedback from participants helped strengthen clarity, relevance, and emotional safety within each activity.



### TPM2 WAS HELD IN VIENNA!

On 27th August 2025, New Horizons partners met in Vienna for the second Transnational Partner Meeting.

The team worked on developing educational resources, planning artistic workshops, and designing public awareness campaigns.

They also reviewed project management and sustainability strategies.
