OBJECTIVES

Creating safe and inclusive learning spaces where migrant youth can express themselves.

Empowering youth workers with creative and practical methods to support migrant youth in their daily practice.

Increasing public awareness to make young people's stories visible and foster empathy within local communities.

Supporting young people's intercultural communication skills through digital tools and interactive activities.

RESULTS

1. A practical guide for youth workers, featuring visual tools, storytelling methods, and various activities that help young people explore & express their experiences.
2. Visual tips and implementation suggestions that youth workers can apply in different contexts.
3. Group activities in each partner country: cultural workshops carried out with young people in Belgium, Türkiye, and Austria.
4. Community events and social media actions designed to raise awareness and increase visibility.
